

The tide may be turning

The end of the financial year is the time to examine the bottom line, compare it with other years and look to the prospects of the future.

Looking back to this time last year there was an air of expectancy throughout the business world.

Voters had decided, that after thirteen years, it was time for a new Government and had voted accordingly, electing the Liberal Government.

Consumer confidence was down under Labor, the economy was flat, with small business in particular in need of an impetus that would kick-start it.

The Hire Industry, being a service industry, dependant on other industries, was feeling the effect of the slow economy. But like all others was hopeful of improvement.

The business world was looking to the new government to provide some concessions that would restore consumer confidence and improve the trading arena.

Unfortunately the improvement that often accompanies a change of government didn't eventuate. The economy remained flat, trading very slow, and the gloomy forecasts returned

Generally speaking, although circumstances differ in each state, the majority of hire companies would put 1996 -1997 down as a tough year, as was last year. But the Hire Industry wasn't alone, as many industries felt the effect of the flat economy.

But a change appears to be on its way. The contiued interest rate cuts have stimulated the economy in some areas; the stock exchange is on a seemingly endless upwards spiral; real estate sales are booming; and retail figures are up for the first time in ages.

Two areas where the Hire Industry is directly involved, the housing industry and the construction industry, after a slump of three years are both showing strong signs of growth

Many economist are predicting that Australia is on the verge of a growth surge with economic growth stimulating inceases in employment with continuing relatively low inflation.

But what is more important is that consumer confidence seems to be returning, and with consumer confidence a major determinant of consumer spending, this will mean improved sales for business.

Although these positive results may not have reached all sectors or regions as yet, this sense of optimism appears to be permeating even those areas who are yet to feel their effects.

Although it may be a bit early to restock your yard with a new range of equipment, or order the new Mercedes. It must be said that the trading environment at the moment looks more promising than it has for a long time. There are no suggestion that there are boom times ahead, just the indication that things are improving and should continue to do so.

After the last few years, any improvement will be gratefully received.

Don Howe - forty years in Hire

fter forty years in hire, Don Howe can look back with satisfaction at his achievements of building a successful hire operation. But it

wasn't always smooth sailing.

Don was originally operating a plumbing & draining business from home in Heathcote in 1955, He found that like all other tradesman in that area there was a gross shortage of available equipment for hire. The nearest company hiring out compressors was A. W. Donnelley in Rozelle. So Don borrowed the deposit from the bank and bought one of his own.

This not only gave Don the advantage of always having one on hand, it also allowed him to hire out his compressor whenever it wasn't in use. Demand soon began to outstrip supply, so he purchased another

and began hiring it out

The shortage of equipment in those days prompted Don to gather together a small range of equipment and set up a hire operation, leasing part of a yard in Kirrawee. Being a plumber and also holding a builders licence he was able to take advantage of the housing boom in the surrounding areas, while also running the hire operation.

Concentrating on excavation, despite a few

setbacks along the way, he gradually built up the hire business until he had 27 Air Compressors, 6 Backhoes, 1 Drott and 10 Trucks and a staff of 24 involved in wet and dry hire. The business soon the leased outgrew premises, so he moved into the Waratah Street premises in Kirrawee thirty five years ago and is still there today.

But the downturn in the economy of 1974 saw the building and housing industries grind almost to a halt. Turnover tumbled

and it was necessary to reduce the staff to a minimum. In twelve months he was forced to reduce staff from 24 down to 4.

Rather than retrench the employees, Don arranged for them to lease the excavation equipment from him, giving them the opportunity to start their own business, while also solving the problem of his

Unfortunately, the recession, couldn't have come at a worse time. Capitalising on the success of the business Don had just paid \$100,000 for the Drott which couldn't be sold, so he was compelled to

concentrate on rockblasting and excavating in order to utilise the Drott. At the time it was normal for him to buy 300lb - 500lb of gelignite a week to help excavate the rocky terrain in order to keep up with growing demand as the suburbs took shape.

The recession taught Don his first lesson. He decided to diversify, by looking at other areas of involvement, and other items to hire out.

Starting out again, almost from scratch, he began to add general hire equipment to his range. He soon acquired the name of "one of everything." Other hire companies advising their clients on the lookout for obscure equipment, " if Howes hasn't got it, it's not available.'

Don always believed in reinvesting in the business, but as well as new equipment he began to invest in commercial property in the area, purchasing the property the business was on. He later invested in other properties in the area, the returns from which came in handy during downturns in the economy.

Don again built the business and the product range up, until 1981 produced another recession. Although not as damaging as the previous one, its effect was felt throughout the industry. Shortly after this Don sold

> the Drott and decided to concentrate his business on the small contractor and home handy man hire, and has continued along these lines ever since, but of course he still lives up to his name 'a few of everything."

> After forty two years in hire having survived the good and bad cycles, Don still sees hire as a good business with plenty of opportunity available. Although there is more opposition now than in preceding years he sees opportunities in the small

contractor hire and home handyman range. With the high cost of tradesmen and the user friendly equipment available now, the prospect of doing it yourself looks much more attractive to the consumer.

Also the Home Handy Man and Small Contractor market does not need the huge capital outlay needed that is necessary when involved with the large contractor, therefore minimising the risk of overexposure to the boom - bust cycles of the construction industry.

Looking at changes that have occurred over the years, Don sees the competitiveness of latter years

leading to hire companies putting representatives on the road, canvassing for work, offering reduced rates and other unsustainable incentives, being detrimental to the industry.

When pressed as to the secret for his success in business, Don pointed to the fact that his wife, Win, always run the office side of the business, leaving him

to look after the operating side, plus the fact that he always had very loyal staff. The rest he put down to fierce determination and hard work.

He has always been on the lookout for new equipment, continually The ARA visiting Convention, hopeful of adding to the range. Pressed to nominate some his favourite of equipment, Don named grinders and stump electric hammers had both good money been

spinners. Adding that both items of equipment were very suitable to the surrounding areas.

Don's longevity in the hire business has seen him built up customer loyalty that led to him inheriting customers, as fathers point their sons in his direction.

There is a lot of experience and a lot of knowledge in forty two years in hire.

His son Glenn joined the business at sixteen and


after twenty three years has taken over the managing of the business in the last few years.

The computerisation of the business, four years ago, has simplified the all round running of the business and has enabled them to more easily keep stock of the huge range of equipment.

Glenn's involvement has enabled Don and Win to

scale down the participation in the business. Although formerly always actively involved in the business Don now can't find enough time to pursue his outside interest.

Taking up Scuba Diving at 45, he now has more time to spend enjoying the sport. Two years ago he retired from competitive squash and took up golf. He is now working on his handicap with the same determination he had in

running his business

But mainly the free time will give Don and Win the opportunity to add to their already imposing record of about eighty trips overseas

One thing is for sure, while they are away Don will be on the lookout for anything that will add to the range of Howes Hire.

The first electric drain cleaning machines used in the Hire Industry were Burton Powersnake, which were introduced by Kennards in the early seventies.


Gordon Esden the General Manager at Super Hire (later to become Coates Hire) at Homebush Bay found this machine did not meet the needs of his trade customers and introduced the Electric Eel Model 'C'. Gordon found the standard kit with cable carriers and a tool box took too much time to inspect for damage or tool loss. He did away with the cable containers and fitted a plate to the machine to take the tools. thus the Hire Kit was developed.

The popularity of the Electric Eel Model "C"

Hire Kit quickly spread and today there a few Hire Companies that do not have one or more Electric Eel's in their yard.

New narrow aisle Work Platform combines compact size, up-and-over reach

ompact dimensions, zero tailswing and an articulating jib make the new AMZ39NE aerial work platform from Grove Manlift ideal for work in narrow aisles and other confined areas.

Thanks to an overall width of just 4 ft. (1.21 m) and a stowed height of just 6 ft. 7 in. (2.0 m), the AMZ39NE fits easily through standard double doorways. For ease of transport and storage, the AMZ39NE's articulating jib folds neatly under the boom, resulting in an overall stowed length of 12 ft. 2 in. (3.7 m) or about the same as an average automobile.





Change and its affect on the industry

he Hire Industry is unique in that through it's diversity and ever increasing product range it has the scope for continuous growth. While providing the alternative to purchasing products, it reaps the benefits of the manufacturing industry in that whatever is produced for industrial or private use may also become part of the product range for hire. Equipment continuously comes onto the market which enhances the hire industry range. The diversity of the product range has allowed the industry to grow and there is no doubt this growth will continue. But changes are occurring in the industry that will determine who will be in the position to take advantages of this growth."

Skip Evans, American Rental Association President, in his Keynote Address to the Hire Association of Europe annual conference in October last year, outlined changes that are occurring in the hire industry in the USA. He said," change is a fact

of business that you can be sure of. The only thing that isn't so sure is what you are going to do about it. I remind myself of that often, because procrastination is the easy way - it's tempting, and I have to guard against it, because the only way to survive is to analyse the situation carefully and without delay, make a decision, and take action."

He added, that what he said applies to the hire industry globally, and there is no doubt that Australia is no exception to the rule.

Looking back at changes that have occurred in the last decade in the hire industry in Australia, from the buoyant days of the mid 80's, who would have foreseen the recession that followed, plus the many changes that have happened since. The Hire Industry being a service industry is continually subjected to industrial and economic change.

But it is not only these outside interest that are having an affect on the hire environment. The Hire Industry has always been so diverse that large and small companies compete over a vast range of areas. But the trading arena is showing signs of change,

Hardware stores hire involvement

Areas of hire have been targeted, by at times, outside interests. The Bunnings Warehouse chain of hardware stores have targeted the home handy man, (DIY) market, by setting up hire operations in their stores. With eight stores in Victoria, two in South Australia and one in Western Australia. Bunnings have a commitment to take the operation national,

with the hire operation as part of the on going expansion. This would appear to be the ideal environment for a hire operation, as an alternative to purchasing equipment which may only be used occasionally. Their operations is also being closely monitored by other hardware chains, with a view to also becoming involved. While individual hardware stores have dabbled in hire previously, with limited success, this is the first time a hardware chain has become involved.

Whether hardware stores can compensate for the experience, service and maintenance structure of hire companies remains to be seen. If so, they promise to become a serious threat to hire companies in future in the DIY range.

Their action follows the example of American hardware stores, who have been involved in hire for some time.

Austrim (who own AH Plant Hire) is an example

of a hire company who have targeted one area of hire. Capitalising on the governments trend towards outsourcing, they purchased the Vic Roads plant and equipment eighteen months ago, and they recently acquired the South Australian Governments road plant, light vehicle and maintenance business, cornering a big part of the road maintenance market.

market.

Some State Government Departments have also entered the hire marketplace by setting up subsidiary hire companies which are successfully competing with hire companies by hiring equipment to other government departments.

Again whether these government hire companies can sustain their involvement remains to be seen. But for the moment their involvement is depriving hire companies of market share.

Smaller hire companies under pressure

Although the three big hire companies, Coates, Wreckair and Kennards, have multiple branches, small hire companies make up the bigger percentage of the hire industry in Australia.

While some of these, through long term involvement have entrenched themselves in the industry, indications are that some of these smaller companies may find the going very tough in the future.

The areas that are being targeted are mainly those in which the smaller hire companies are involved.

With the the necessity of reinvesting in the

business, as equipment becomes more sophisticated .Plus the cost of compliance with Occupational Health and Safety and Environmental regulations, increasing the cost of running a business. The task of some smaller hire companies to compete successfully in the already very competitive marketplace, may become more difficult in the future.

On top of this you have the trend towards hire companies becoming public listed companies on the stock exchange, thereby increasing their capitalisation and their buying power. Public Companies have an obligation to their shareholders which places them under greater pressure to produce profitable results and grow their business.

Perhaps the smaller hire operators may be better looking for a niche industry within hire, or diversifying their involvement, rather than be competing in the "heavy traffic" areas of hire.

Areas of hire sometimes tend to become overserviced. The Access Industry is one which has captured the interest of the hire industry. The growth in usage over the last decade has seen Elevating Work Platforms become almost a necessary part of every hire companies range, large and small, contributing towards a very congested marketplace, with reduced margins, involving equipment that has such a large capital outlay.

We have outlined some of the changes which are occurring in the hire industry, and they will not be the last. While the marketplace may appear to be diminishing for some, in reality the future growth of the hire industry seems assured.

Because of it's depth of involvement at the moment, combined with the continual flow of new products, plus new areas of utilisation of equipment being found, opening up new marketplaces and opportunities, ensure that the industry will continue to grow.

But in what areas this growth will come is the question only time will answer.

Maybe hire companies in future will have to become more selective in their areas of involvement. The areas of profitability of today may not be those of tomorrow,

But only those companies who put themselves in the position to take advantage of the changes that are occurring and opportunities that present themselves will be the winners.

Selecting the right areas of involvement is the art of good business and receives it's just rewards.

In our next issue we will seek the opinion from hire operators and suppliers in the industry, as to the changes that are occurring and their views where they see the industry heading in the future.



New Safety Information Cards for DIY Equipment

For some years, injuries sustained from the use of DIY equipment have been a significant and growing concern for both hire companies and regulatory authorities.

At last, a new set of simple and practical safety information cards have been prepared for 38 pieces of DIY equipment. The cards are easy to read, contain clear instructions and are presented in the form of an compact laminated card (215 mm x 150 mm).

The safety information cards provide information on recommended protective equipment that should be worn, such as ear muffs or face shields and specific safety instructions in relation to the operation of the equipment.

The safety information cards have been developed to raise safety awareness among hire industry employees and customers and reinforce the importance of using hire equipment safely. Use of the safety information cards can assist equipment hirers to meet their legal obligations in relation to health and safety and minimise public liability risks.

The cards can be personalised to include company details and logo for individual organisations .

In a project funded by the Victorian WorkCover Authority and supported by the Hire & Rental Association of Australia, Noel Arnold & Associates, a leading Victorian health and safety consulting firm have produced an initial set of 38 safety information cards for equipment typically hired in the domestic Do-It-Yourself markets.

Elevating Work Platforms rate highly on world markets

ndoubtably the item of equipment that has made the biggest impact on the Hire and Rental Industry in the last decade is Elevating Work Platforms.

The impact has been global, as Elevating Work Platforms have integrated themselves into the industrial scene worldwide. With their main focus of involvement being the construction industry.

The Australian market is recognised in the world as being in the top ten markets for

Elevating Work Platforms.

While Elevating Work Platforms have been on the global scene for some time the units have only been operating in Australia in volume for about fifteen years. They only became established in the mid 1980's in Australia during the construction boom. At that time there were several suppliers on the scene but the recession that followed saw most of these disappear.

Despite a period following this of limited utilisation, improvement in the market since 1993 has seen an influx of new suppliers until, now the end user has the choice of 8 different brands of self propelled units competing for market share which is estimated to be \$30M - \$40M in 1997.

The rental industry usage accounts for 70% of sales in Australia and 70% of rental industry units are engaged in the construction industry. While most Elevating Work Platforms manufacturers are developing units for the industrial market, to meet the predicted increase in sales to this industry,to spread the usage of platforms.

But sales of the units rely on the expanding construction industry, and most probably always will.

The usage of Elevating Work Platforms in Australia is increasing rapidly due to the the price reduction on equipment over the past ten years, plus the reduction in duty from 20% down to as little as 3%, the Australian dollar firming against the US dollar and the manufacturer passing on their efficiencies in volume manufacturing.

In comparison with the USA and Japanese markets in the use of Elevating Work Platforms, the Australian construction market is lagging, says Ross Hogan, Managing Director of Snorkel, in Australia.

During a visit to Japan in May 1997,Ross observed that "the most popular unit in the construction market was the 4 meter platform height Self Propelled Scissorlift for multi-story construction, which is certainly not the practice in Australia at the moment.Also on visits to the

USA he found Self Propelled Booms and Scissorlifts engaged on residential construction, which is also not the practice in Australia."

Comparing the market size between the USA - Australia - Japan, Ross said "there were 23,000 scissorlifts and 13,000 booms manufactured in the USA in 1996."

"Less than 15% of these were exported outside of America, so if you divide 35,000 units by 260 million Americans and you compare that with the 1,500 units sold in Australia divided by 18.5 million Australians, per capita the usage of platforms is 40% down in Australia".

"The wage comparison between Australia, America and Japan is closing and therefore this should generate the use of more Elevating Work Platforms within the Australian market".Ross

went on to say.

Along with JLG, Snorkel have been the market leaders in Australia for fifteen years. Ross maintains that the main reason for Snorkel's continued market share has been their commitment to after-sales-service. Built up over their years of involvement, with branches in every state. Snorkel pride themselves on the experience of their staff.

"We believe we have the best and most experienced staff in Australia," Ross said

"In each state the Management and Service Department have a minimum of ten years experience working with Snorkel products. With each location employing their own Serviceman who can supply spare parts off the shelf. Emphasising the fact that Snorkel have made a long term commitment to the Australian construction market and are here for a long time".

Looking to the future of the Elevating Work Platforms in Australia, Ross sees the prospects over the next three years to be very encouraging. Snorkel has more new units in the final testing than they have ever in the last 25 years. New models to be released late in 1997 by Snorkel are, low cost Slab Scissors, state of the art Articulated Up and Over Self Propelled Booms and large 40 meter Self Propelled Booms.

ACM/s sweeper range makes debris collection easy

Australian Mower Company (AMC) based at Horsham, Victoria has introduced a three model range of petrol engine powered trailed sweepers, for the collection of leaves, grass, litter and similar debris including dried animal droppings.

There are three models in the range, all powered by Briggs & Stratton Vanguard overhead valve petrol engines. Each model is designed to be towed behind a vehicle, ranging from a ride-on mower in the case of the smaller model, to a small garden tractor, all terrain vehicle, light utility or a tractor in the case of the two larger models.

In all three machines the catcher is hinged and is easily open' to deposit the load of collected waste material and debris. In t! two larger models, the catcher is activated by two hydraulic cylinders. The pick-up height of each sweeper is adjustable an' all three models are designed to provide positive collection at any ground speed, even in reverse.

Australian Mower Company's managing director, Gary Pilgrim, said that the sweeper units are designed and manufactured at Horsham, Vic. and are quickly achieving a satisfied user base with commercial bodies including Councils, sports facility managers and golf courses.



SURROUNDING ENVIRONMENT, EMISSIONS TO WATERCOURSES AND SITE APPEARANCE

Your activities should not have an adverse impact on surrounding areas or on neighbours in appearance or potential for pollution. Any pollution which can eventually make its way to a watercourse can have significant consequences. Site appearance is important to your business and has an enormous affect on how customers feel about your business and the Equipment Hire and Rental Industry. An audit should include the following questions:

- Is the site adjacent to a watercourse? (THIS IS A KEY POINT.)
- If the site is not bonded, could a spilt liquid enter a council drain or natural watercourse? (IF SO, RESULTS COULD BE DEVASTATING ON YOUR BUSINESS.)
- Is stormwater on unroofed areas where equipment is stored or maintained, handled according to local Water Authority, Council or EPA requirements

NOTE: The above hazards need immediate attention as pollution of waterways is serious and carries very heavy penalties. If they exist at you site, get expert advice promptly.

- Is the site adjacent to any environmental, sensitive area such as a school or residential area, or public park?
- Is there any new development proposal in the immediate area that could be affected by, or affect your company's drainage or containment facilities?
- Are your outside boundaries and adjacent areas in good condition? Includes fences (no graffiti), footpaths, gutters, company signs and logo, nature strip, etc.

Inside your boundaries, - building/paintwork etc. of good appearance, no weeds, litter, builders' rabble, junk machinery, etc?

THE APPEARANCE OF YOUR SITE IS AN IMPORTANT FACTOR IN THE WAY CUSTOMERS, VISITORS AND THE COMMUNITY PERCEIVE YOUR BUSINESS. IF IT LOOKS 'SLOPPY', THE IMPRESSION WILL BE THAT A 'DON'T CARE' ATTITUDE ALSO EXTENDS TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

ALLOWING POLLUTION TO ESCAPE FROM YOUR SITE AND ENTER A WATERWAY IS A SERIOUS OFFENCE AND CAN BE CAUSED BY SPILLS, LEAKAGE, OR STORMWATER RUN-OFF

STORAGE

Adequate storage methods for toxic or environmentally hazardous materials, with proper precautions against spills or leaks, are essential to prevent pollution. An audit should make sure that all chemicals, fuel, lubricants, etc. are properly stored.

- Is there a list of all toxic or hazardous chemicals with normal quantities held? (Known as a Chemicals Manifest or Register and preferably having Material Safety Data Sheets for each item). Exempt only very small quantities, say ,less than 5 kg or 5 litres. List all materials listed in the current "Australian Code for the Transport of Goods by Road or Rail Regulation" known as the "ADG Code". They include, LPG, flammable and combustible liquids and solids, oxidising substances, poison and corrosive substances.
- Are all fuel dispensing and filling points, above ground storage of fuel, lubricants, detergents or other cleaners, degreasing compounds, and toxic chemicals bunded?

NOTE: All banding has to comply with both Dangerous Goods regulations for safety and EPA requirements for environment protection. Use whichever is the most severe requirement. See Appendix 10.6 for general environmental requirements on banding. Check with local EPA, council water authority, or consultant for exact requirements.

- Check that bunding has not been breached or interfered with illegally, or full of rainwater and not pumped out in the prescribed way.
- Are any environmentally hazardous liquids stored in drums, and are the drains in good condition?
- Are there any empty drums on site that could contain residues and how are they disposed of?
- Are there any electrical capacitors or transformers on site that may contain PCBs, and if so are they checked regularly for leaks?
- Are there any BCF or Halon fire extinguishers on site?

NOTE: BCF or Halon fire extinguishers can only be USED to fight a fire and must be decommissioned according to regulations by 31st December 1995. Use after that date is illegal.

STORAGE OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS MUST COMPLY WITH BOTH SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS. REFER TO APPROPRIATE LOCAL PROFESSIONAL EXPERTS FOR ADVICE ON STORAGE OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES. TO AVOID HARSH PENALTIES FOR CONTAMINATED RUN-OFF INTO STORMWATER CHANNELS, CLOSE INSPECTION OF BONDING IS ESSENTIAL. PROFESSIONAL ASSESSMENT SHOULD BE SOUGHT IF ANY DOUBT EXISTS ABOUT COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS.

EMERGENCY PLANNING AND RESPONSE FOR ENVIRONMENTALLY DAMAGING INCIDENTS

- Is there an emergency response plan covering fire, explosion and environmentally damaging incidents?
- Does the emergency plan include evacuation, location of emergency equipment, a plan of the site, procedures for containment of environmentally damaging substances, a manifest of all hazardous substances and a list of persons to contact?

NOTE: The main purpose of emergency plans is to protect persons. Secondary, kin very Important purposes, are to protect property and material and prevent environmental pollution. Failing to include environment protection can lead to serious consequences. This procedure deals with environmental Issues only.

- Is there a procedure for interaction before, during and after an emergency, with Emergency Authorities, including Fire Brigade, Water/Sewerage Authority, EPA, local Council and other appropriate local response authority?
- Have evacuation and containment plans been discussed with neighbours?
- Have staff been trained to handle fuel or other liquid spills?
- Are practice emergency drill carried out (fire, spills, evacuation)?

- Is suitable equipment and material available for containing spills and extinguishing fires?
- How would any contamination contained on-site be disposed of?
- Who is the responsible officer for:
- emergency procedures and control during the emergency?
- liaison with emergency services?
- liaison with environmental regulatory authorities?
- maintaining the chemical manifest and material safety data sheets (MSDS)?
- maintaining a list of company emergency contacts, including after hours phone?

NOTE: Specific responsibility should be allocated for each of the above tasks. More than one person may be involved for each responsibility.

DO NOT OVERLOOK ENVIRONMENTAL DAMAGE CONTROL IN EMERGENCY PROCEDURES, (but people safety comes first). REVIEW ALL PROCEDURES WITH EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND REGULATORY AUTHORITIES AND HAVE PRACTICE DRILLS REGULARLY.



HYDRAULIC PUMPS

Now that we know the principles of hydraulics Pascals Law and the three types of pumps most commonly used in our Industry, we will move onto oils viscosity and directional control valves.

HYDRAULIC OIL

Whether a specially compounded petroleum oil or one of the special fire-resistant fluids, which may be a synthetic compound, the selection and care of a hydraulic fluid force machine will have an important effect on how it performs and on the life of the hydraulic components.

The hydraulic fluid has four primary purposes;

· To transmit power, to lubricate moving parts; to seal clearances between arts and to dissipate heat.

In addition to the four primary functions an oil must also have some quality requirements such as;

- · Prevent rust, pitting.
- · Prevent formation of sludge, gum or varnish.
- · Depress foaming.
- · Maintain its own stability over wide temperature ranges.
 - · Separate water.
 - · Compatibility with seals and gaskets.

These quality requirements will often be added when blending of oil takes place.

VISCOSITY

Defined as an oil's ability to flow in varying temperature conditions.

DIRECTIONAL CONTROL VALVES


These are used in a hydraulic system to control the direction of flow to an actuator cylinder or motor producing direction movement. Though they vary in construction and operation considerably Direction Control Valves (DCVs) used in the hire industry equipment are mostly lever operated spool or battery voltage operated coil type DCVs.

LEVER OPERATED

Where an operator pulls on a lever which is connected to a spool which has springs at either end of the spool. So that when the lever is released the springs overcome the movement of the hydraulic oil and return the spool to a predetermined central position.

COIL TYPE

Where a remote electric signal is sent to a coil mounted over the spool to be moved. Once energised a magnetic field pulls the spool towards it allowing oil to pass through. The springs at either end returns the spool to its normal position once the electric signal is turned off.



RELIEF VALVES

These are often found in the hydraulic systems in our industry's equipment. Whether remotely mounted or incorporated within a valve bank, these valves are often overlooked when problems arise.

As the name reads Relief Valve, they do just that to a hydraulic system. Protecting the component within the circuit from any excessive oil pressure and flow and returning it to tank.

It is a normally closed valve connected between the pressure line (pump outlet) and the reservoir.

In most relief valves an adjusting screw is provided to vary the spring force. Thus the valve can be set to open at any pressure within its specified range.

Some relief valves are adjusted by either adding or subtracting metal shims above the spring.

Note: Whenever making any adjustments to a relief valve ensure a pressure gauge (with capabilities greater than that of the system's rated maximum pressure) is used in the line **before** the relief valve.

I will incorporate hydraulic symbols in our next issue and place them in a schematic. Also, I will discuss filtration and why it is so important.

Business Capital The money and how to get it

The financial or capital structure of your business is one of the key areas that will influence the outcome of your efforts. In other words, whether or not you will be as profitable as you can be.

The three primary sources of capital available to businesses are:

- Shareholders' Equity i.e. your money and that of other investors
- · Borrowed Funds
- Reserves i.e. profits put back into the business. In this guide we discuss raising capital via borrowings.

Once you have decided to raise capital by borrowing money, you need to consider whether short, medium or long term finance will be most suitable for your needs.

Importantly, you will need to match the terms of the loan to the purpose for which the finance is being used.

TYPES OF FINANCE

Business finance can be categorised as:

- · Short term
- · Medium term
- Long term.

SHORT TERM FINANCE

This form of finance is commonly called 'working capital' and is the capital (money) required to fund the day-to-day running of the business. Working capital should not be used for long term projects as it is generally more expensive (in terms of interest rate charges) than money paid back over a longer period.

Short term finance or working capital typically comes in the following forms:

Bank Overdraft - An overdraft can be used to cover financing shortfalls from day-to-day according to your cash flow. The interest will be calculated on your daily outstanding balance and is usually charged on a quarterly basis. Depending on your financier, an overdraft facility may also incur other sundry fees.

Commercial Bill - is an arrangement where money is made available for a short period. At the end of the period an unconditional order is made on you to repay

the borrowed amount. Commercial Bills can be drawn for terms ranging from 30 days up to a maximum of 180 days. They are commonly used to meet the seasonal funding needs of a business.

Debtor Finance (commonly known as Factoring) -

is an arrangement where a finance company provides a cash advance to the business against sales made (invoices). The 'loan' is repaid when the debtor pays the invoice.

MEDIUM TERM FINANCE

This is finance usually required for a 3 to 10 year period and is principally used by businesses to finance equipment, business expansion and development of new products.

Medium term finance may come in the following forms:

Term Loans - is a loan paid back over an agreed period (term) where principal and interest rate are paid off in monthly repayments. This type of facility is commonly used by businesses who wish to structure their loan repayments to correspond with the income produced from equipment purchased or sales of new products. It may be for a 5 or 10 year period.

Personal Loans - Where it is not possible to arrange a loan in your business' name you could consider as an alternative arranging a personal loan. This can then be contributed as equity or a loan to the business.

Leasing - With this type of facility the financier would purchase the equipment you require and then lease it to you in return for regular rental payments (usually monthly) for the duration of the lease period. At the completion of the lease term you are then offered the option to purchase the equipment at an agreed residual value.

LONG TERM FINANCE

This type of finance is used to fund the purchase of assets such as the business itself, land, buildings, plant or machinery which will directly or indirectly contribute to profit over a period of years. Term Loans would be the most common way to structure long term borrowings.

APPLYING FOR A LOAN

You will need to supply information on:

THE BUSINESS

If you are buying an existing business, or you are already in business, a short description of your business - its history, past achievements, products and services - should be provided. Also include the number of staff involved, the location and a description of the premises, machinery, equipment, vehicles and other key assets.

If you are starting up a new business, describe the

products and services you intend to provide, how you intend to bring in business by marketing, and what you have of demand for your products/services.

YOUR HISTORY

You should provide details of your own educational and business qualifications, business experience (whether it relates to your present business or not) and past achievements.

AMOUNT AND PURPOSE

The amount and details of the purpose for which the loan would be utilised should be stated clearly in your proposal.

REPAYMENT

It will be important from the lender's point of view to be able to clearly establish how the loan repayments will be made.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Projection of sales, cash flow, profits etc over the term of the loan should be prodded and, for an existing business seeking funds, the last three years' annual accounts. You should also include a monthly cash flow budget for the 12 months ahead with the loan repayments included.

Other information - Lenders may also require details of any current Debtors and Creditors and a valuation of stock on hand.

SECURITY

It is likely the lender will seek some form of security from you to protect the loan. Security requirements will vary between lenders and the type of loan sought. Some generally acceptable forms of security are:

- Real Estate
- Shares in Public Companies
- · Surrender Value of an Insurance Policy
- · Personal Guarantee
- Bill of Sale, or Debenture over assets other than Real Estate

Safety Instructions for this Equipment

- Apply light steady pressure to feed work past the blade. Excessive force should not be used.
- · Use several shallow cuts, not one deep cut.
- Set the machine up on level ground to ensure both the machine and the operator are stable.
- Ensure an adequate supply of water on both sides of the blade. This will ensure there is no blade damage and will reduce dust generation.
- Always support the material to be cut on the table. Never hold the work to be cut by hand alone.
- Ensure that the ribbed mat is fixed to the table at all time as it provides a non skid surface to support the work.
- Ensure the rubber splash apron is fitted at all times as it functions to keep water spray off the motor.
- Do not allow waste water to accumulate under foot.
- Do not stand in line with the blade when starting the machine.
- Ensure the material to be cut will remain stable and will not move or fall while cutting.
- Never allow thumbs or other parts of hands in line with blade.
