

GST means Get Started Today

As the introduction date of the GST approaches it is becoming increasingly aware, from surveys conducted, that many small businesses have not yet put into place plans for the implementation of the GST into their business. Some put this tardiness down to the confusion caused by the political footballing over the issue. Where as others seem to be complacent about it with a "it will be alright on the day' attitude.

Although it will eventually become part and parcel of everyday business practice, it is not like going to the grocer where 10% will be added to your purchase and you pay it.

The introduction of the GST will change the way we do business in many ways. For instance, with the abolition of Sales Tax it will herald in a new set a prices on items we use in our businesses, which is sure to create some initial confusion. Some items will be 22% cheaper due to no sales tax but still liable for 10% GST, therefore decreasing the cost by 12%. Computer hardware will fit into this bracket, but the cost of software will increase by 10% on its present price. This is just one of the examples of some of the complexities which the GST brings with it.

The training of staff and the implementation of the the GST into your present financial operating system or the introduction of a latter day system with the GST incorporated is going to be a costly, time consuming exercise., The printing of new stationery ,plus liaising with both suppliers and customers to discuss the new pricing structure is all part of the necessary process of the introduction of the GST.

Another headache looming for small business is cash flow. They are going to have to factor into their cash flow the quarterly payments of GST. This may present a problem to Rental Companies because of their multiple transactions.

Regardless whether a business uses the accrual accounting system or a cash accounting system a business becomes liable for GST on any invoices from the day on which they are sent out, in the GST accounting period, not on when they are paid. They will all be liable to pay the GST every three months.

The Tax Office will probably show a bit of compassion in the early stages of the GST in regard to payments, but it would be unwise to expect this too last. They are not known for their patience where payments are concerned.

While there are going to be transitional hurdles to overcome which we will all learn to live with, the GST will also deliver benefits to the business sector.

Whether one outweighs the other can only be determined in time. It is something all businesses will sink or swim with.



As share prices of internet stocks on financial markets continue to soar the direction of activity of internet company's is changing.

The Internet initially was thought to be the avenue which would revolutionise retailing to the consumer. (B2C) The internets global access was going to create a huge shopping centre from which the consumer would be able to purchase all his needs. He would never have to leave home again, everything would be just a mouse click away.

Companies stampeded to be part of the new etailing boom, which was going to replace the traditional shopping method of the consumers. Its cost effectiveness and convenience were seen as part of the new technological advancement in business strategy. It was soon possible to purchase anything from a match to a Boeing Jet via the net.

Early losses were seen as set up costs as profits become a low priority, with the accent on developing market share and customer loyalty. The light appeared very bright at the end of the tunnel and investors were easy to find.

The internet became the gold rush demand of the present day, This was emphasised when at the last Super Bowl, the costliest advertising venue in the world at \$US 1 million for a 30 second advert, there were 14 internet companies plying their wares.

Amazon.com, the role model of e-tailers, started selling books from a garage, then went public in 1997.

Their sales of impersonal goods which didn't have to be tried on for size or checked for freshness was seen an ideal e-tailing venture. Their stock price became a rocket and they were an example of the new economy companies which were building up huge customer bases. Their stock price rose to \$US200 at one stage, despite continually racking up huge losses. But with 12million customers on line how could you continue to lose? Amazon's added CDS and Pharmeceticuls to their range but still couldn't turn the operation into a profitable one. Three years on they are still can't predict when they will make a profit. Which provides plenty of ammunition for their detractors. If you can't make a profit with such a customer base, who can?

Smaller companies who had joined the e-tailing wave have fared even worse. Despite huge marketing campagnes the conversion of consumers into net shoppers just hasn't eventuated. Few companies, if any, have found a way to to make their operations viable. Part of this is put down to the competitiveness

of the marketplace, everybody was online, there are up 1500 shoe shops on the net in the US, for instance. Investors are now deserting the ship and stock prices plummeting. It would appear that the B2C dream is over.

It is not to say that the game is over for all concerned in the B2C area. Companies like Amazon with their huge customer base still may find a way, but it will be too late for most.

It has really been a remarkable period where companies with a history of losses, no assets and unable to predict when they will make a profit were still able to attract investors by the droves.

It is an indication of the confidence in the future of the internet

But, one of the main asset of the internet is because

of its global access it provides the opportunity for so much commercial activity. While the B2C boom has been going on there has been many other aspects of internet activity happening. The trend has now switched to Business to Business activity, which is booming and is predicted to turn over \$US2trillion by 2004.

Meanwhile, the Internet has become part of the business structure worldwide with participation dependent on the type of business you are in. Ways of utilising the net in particular businesses environments are top priorities. One thing is for sure everybody will need to be online, its a service your customers will demand.

Overseas, Rental Companies are becoming more involved in net activity. From using the net as communication avenue for e-mail, displaying inventory and rates, viewing new equipment in action from suppliers, to receiving orders for the supply of equipment. The extent of this activity is expected to increase dramatically in the near future.

After all the hire of equipment is generally a very impersonal transaction,. If a contractor wants 5 Skid Steers on site Monday at 8.00 am and he is satisfied the Hire Company can supply these goods why wouldn't he utilise the net to place his order. In this case the net is only an extension of the fax or phone, but is so much more versatile.

The internet is seen as an integral part of future rental operations overseas. The interactivity online between Rental Companies and clients is going to increase



Main Road Department go with the flow

After much success with their other Mustang Skid Steer Loaders, the Queensland Main Roads Department, has recently purchased two Mustang 2070 Hi-Flow Skid Steer from Tutts-Tat Hong. The 2070 Hi-Flow is the most powerful and largest skid steer in the Mustang range, and is an ideal machine for those wanting more from their Skid Steer.

The optional Hi-flow feature which is now available on Mustangs smaller models the 2050 and 2060 as well as the 2070, increases the machines overall hydraulic pump capacity, and improves the ability to run optional attachments such as earth auger's and concrete hammers. In the instance of the Main Roads Department, they will primarily be using the machine to run a road profiler, which also requires water storage to be mounted to the roof of the machine.

The Hi-Flow operation enables the contractor to buy one machine instead of buying five or six by choosing several attachments to use that machine for a variety of applications, like site clearing, lifting and carrying, backfilling, landscaping and confined area applications.

Other features included in the machine sold to the MRD include the optional Two Pin Fast-A-Tach, as well as T-Bar steering/Foot Controls. The 2070 Hiflow is powered by the Isuzu 4JBIT Turbo diesel engine producing 75HP and with the Hi-Flow option delivering 378pm at 3000 psi. In addition, the 2070 has 6,500 Ibs of axle torque and traction effort with 6,000 lb bucket breakout force.

All Mustang models feature a no maintenance

direct drive coupler with large drive pumps and massive wheel motors. Mustangs "bowtie" drive system, increases drive system strength and performance while eliminating the need for internal chain adjustments.

Servicing of the Mustang machines has been simplified with a large swing out rear engine compartment door, flip up seat, easily removable ROPS and large side frame access panels. All fluid checks are easily accessible or fitted with visual sight gauges, plus the hydraulic system is sealed and pressurized to keep out unwanted dirt and contaminants.

With over 80,000 Operator (yellow) Cards issued in three years the success of the current

This program is to ensure that all issuers of Yellow Cards meet a nationally recognised standard of training ability. In this case "Workplace Trainer Level 2" is the standard to go for and together with the able assistance and resources of NMIT, the national training upgrade is underway.

This means that within the next year all current issuers of Yellow Cards must go on a 4-

day course or prove they already have the required Level 2 qualifications.

Pilot courses have already been successfully run in Vic and NSW with more scheduled for SA, Qld and WA. Initially carried out by NMIT Trainers it is planned to have suitably qualified members carry out these courses over the next few months to ensure the rapid upgrade of standard of trainers.

Productivity lift for structural steel fabricator

The Victorian structural steel fabricating and erection group, Skrobar Engineering, was looking for ways to speed up access to above ground work areas on job sites. Giving riggers and site welders faster, safe and easier access to work areas above ground level has been a key consideration for Frank Skrobar, the company's Managing Director.

"If we can use an EWP that can get our people to the work site more easily and more quickly, it can make a significant difference to our timetables," said Frank.

"Some years ago we bought our own EWP, an articulating boom. But, then we had cause to hire an additional later model unit to keep our work programme on track. When using the later model we experienced a significant gain in productivity," added Frank.

With this experience in mind, Frank Skrobar decided to look at the various makes of articulating boom units on the market to see if he could gain another advance in productivity by using a unit with superior features.

Reach was one of the key issues, so a deciding factor was the specs for the fly jib.

Skrobar Engineering found that the new EWP from Haulotte, the model HA16PX, enabled access to a larger working area with the positive and negative articulating fly jib. It offered a total movement of 70 degrees above the horizontal and 70 degrees below the horizontal position.

"When we combined this advantage with the superior horizontal reach of 9.1m and the continuous 360 degree rotation, we found our riggers could do more work before having to stop and re-position the unit. The 360 degrees of continuous rotation is also a major advantage for us."

Whilst discussing re-positioning of self propelled EWPis, the manoeuvrability, turning radius and four wheel steer were identified as key issues for increasing the productivity of the riggers and site welders.

The operators at Skrobar engineering invariably look for good traction and high ground clearance to get over rutted ground ... uneven ground and sandy conditions. The HA16PXis 4 x 4 rough terrain capability combined with a ground clearance of 350mm made the unit ideally sited to their construction sites.

In the past, when using EWPis the Skrobar personnel experienced a significant drop off on operating speeds when more than one movement was selected. They concluded that there is need for a hydraulic system that ensures optimum operating speeds, irrespective of the number of functions being used at the one time.

Operators on construction sites invariably look for good traction and high ground clearance to get over rutted ground ... uneven ground and sandy conditions. The HA16PXis 4 x 4 rough terrain capability combined with a ground clearance of 350mm made this unit an ideal choice.

"Our operators have also recognised the advantage of having the dead manis controls incorporated in the joy sticks, thereby eliminating the conventional foot operated dead man control and leaving the entire basket floor area clear. "As to the platform, we find there is also a good loading carrying capacity ... all up 250kg. And, a 180 degree hydraulic basket rotation helps increase the users productivity at the workface," concluded Frank.
